

Houston District & Fort Bend Area Office






- Plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in six counties: Brazoria, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Montgomery and Waller.
- Encompasses 5,856 square miles.
- Serves approximately 6.9 million people.
- Approximately 5.3 million registered vehicles.
- Nearly 1,200 employees
- Seven area offices and nine maintenance sections.
- \$1.5+B Const & Maint Expenditures


Houston District & Fort Bend Area Office



- Oversee Fort Bend and Waller County operations
- 1300 lanes miles (FBC); 600 lane miles (WC)
- 818K pop (FBC); 56K pop (WC)
- 661K reg veh (FBC); 57K reg veh (WC)
- 41 emp (FBAO); 30 emp (FBMO); 26 emp (WMO)
- \$153.1 million Const & Maint (FBC)
- \$41.3 million Const & Maint (WC)








IH 69 from FM 2759 to Reading Rd.

- Widen from 4-lane divided highway to an 8-lane highway with HOV and frontage roads
- Let Date: Aug 2014
- Est. Cost: \$156.0 million
- Est. Completion Date: 2nd Qtr 2022
- Remaining Work: Punchlist items






IH 69 from Reading Rd. to Spur 10

- Widen from 4-lane divided highway to a 6-lane highway
- Let Date: Jan 2014
- Est. Cost: \$135.9 million
- Est. Completion Date: 2nd Qtr 2023
- Remaining Work: SH 36 intersection; NB mainlane and frontage road work between SH 36 and Spur 10; Reconstruct frontage road between FM 2218 and SH 36






IH 69 from Spur 10 to Darst Rd.

- Widen from 4-lane divided highway to a 6-lane highway
- Let Date: Dec 2015
- Est. Cost: \$100.0 million
- Est. Completion Date: 2nd Qtr 2022
- Remaining Work: Mainlane and frontage road work between Spur 10 and Isleib Rd.






IH 69 from Darst Rd. to Wharton C/L

- Widen from 4-lane divided highway to a 6-lane highway
- Let Date: Jul 2016
- Est. Cost: \$37.7 million
- Est. Completion Date: 2nd Qtr 2022
- Remaining Work: Punchlist items






SH 36 from FM 2218 to Needville-Fairchilds Rd.

- Widen from 2-lane highway to a 4-lane divided highway
- Let Date: Sep 2019
- Est. Cost: \$81.8 million
- Est. Completion Date: 3rd Qtr 2025
- Remaining Work: 30% complete






SH 36 from Needville-Fairchilds Rd. to Brazoria C/L

- Widen from 2-lane highway to a 4-lane divided highway
- Let Date: Sep 2019
- Est. Cost: \$42.3 million
- Est. Completion Date: 3rd Qtr 2023
- Remaining Work: 30% complete






FM 2218 from IH 69 to SH 36

- Widen from a 2-lane highway to a 4-lane highway with raised medians
- Let Date: Jun 2020
- Est. Cost: \$43.6 million
- Est. Completion Date: 1st Qtr 2024
- Remaining Work: 45% complete






US 90A at UPRR Underpass

- Replace railroad underpass
- Let Date: Jan 2017
- Est. Cost: \$18.4 million
- Est. Completion Date: 4th Qtr 2024
- Remaining Work: 25% complete






FM 1463 from IH 10 to FM 1093

- Widen from 2-lane highway to a 6-lane highway (N of Spring Green Rd.) and 4lane highway (S of Spring Green Rd.) with raised medians
- Let Date: Aug 2021
- Est. Cost: \$108.4 million
- Est. Completion Date: 2nd Qtr 2025
- Remaining Work: 10% complete






FM 1092 from IH 69 to SH 6

- Install raised median
- Let Date: Aug 2021
- Est. Cost: \$2.4 million
- Est. Completion Date: 3rd Qtr 2022
- Remaining Work: 15% complete





FM 359 from Waller C/L to FM 1093

ACP Overlay


Let Date: Dec 2021

• Est. Cost: \$1.4 million

Est. Completion Date: 2nd Qtr 2022

Remaining Work: 50% complete





IH 10 from Brazos River to FM 359 (Brookshire, TX)

- Widen to 6 and 8-lane highway
- Let Date: Jun 2017
- Est. Cost: \$142.0 million
- Est. Completion Date: 2nd Qtr 2024
- Remaining Work: 75% complete




FM 723 from Brazos River to FM 1093

- Widen from a 2-lane highway to a 4-lane highway with raised medians
- Let Date: Aug 2022
- Est. Cost: \$109.4 million

SH 99 from FM 1093 to IH 10

- Widen from a 4-lane highway to a 6-lane highway; SB frontage road between Fry Rd. and FM 1093
- Let Date: Aug 2022
- Est. Cost: \$89.0 million

Replace existing pan girder bridges

Let Date: Sep 2022


Est. Cost: \$3.3 million

 Widen from 2-lane highway to a 4-lane divided highway

Let Date: Dec 2022

Est. Cost: \$45.0 million





US 90A from FM 359 to SH 99

 Widen from 4-lane highway to a 6-lane divided highway

Let Date: Jan 2023


Est. Cost: \$34.2 million

Construct grade separation and intersection improvements

Let Date: May 2023

Est. Cost: \$29.0 million






FM 521 from SH 6 to FM 2234

Let Date: Apr 2023

Est. Cost: \$82.2 million






IH 10 from Snake Creek to Harris C/L

- Widen from 6-lane highway to a 10-lane highway (2 Gen Purpose & 2 Diamond)
- Let Date: Jun 2023
- Est. Cost: \$128.2 million

IH 10 from Waller C/L to Snake Creek

- Widen from 6-lane highway to a 10-lane highway (2 Gen Purpose & 2 Diamond)
- Let Date: Aug 2023
- Est. Cost: \$78.0 million






IH 10 from FM 359 to Fort Bend C/L (Brookshire, TX)

 Widen from 6-lane highway to a 10-lane highway (2 Gen Purpose & 2 Diamond)

Let Date: Dec 2023

Est. Cost: \$281.5 million



Since Nov. 7, 2000, over 75,000 people have died on Texas roadways.

We've had **21** years straight of daily deaths on Texas roads.





1,413 people were killed in 2020 in speeding related crashes.

714 pedestrians were killed in 2020 in traffic crashes.





The majority of all deadly crashes are due to mistakes drivers make (e.g., texting and driving and drinking and driving).

367 people were killed in 2020 in distracted driving crashes.





1 in 4 people were killed in traffic crashes where a driver was under the influence of alcohol in 2020.

1,078 unbuckled people died in 2020 in traffic crashes.





We average 3,571 fatalities each year - the equivalent of 10 jumbo jets full of people.

Here's what you can do:

- Buckle up: Seat belts are your first line of defense.
- Drive the speed limit, or slower, depending on road or weather conditions.
- Never drive under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Plan a sober ride home.
- When driving, put your phone away or set to "Do Not Disturb".
